EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 001, SERIES 2020

EXECUTIVE ORDER PERTAINING TO ABOVE GROUND POOLS

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020 President Donald J. Trump declared a national state of emergency in response to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020 Governor Andy Beshear declared a state of emergency in Kentucky in response to the first documented case of the novel coronavirus, COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, whereas Governor Beshear has authorized public pools to reopen on June 29, 2020 but it is unclear whether public pools will reopen, or under what conditions they will reopen; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to assist its residents to have some recreational summer diversions, particularly those residents with small children,

NOW THEREFORE, effective on June 5, 2020, the following guidelines shall apply to the utilization of certain backyard pools in Seneca Gardens:

1. One backyard pool having inflatable walls, and which are not over 36" in height and no longer than 15 feet or if round, which have a diameter not greater than 15 feet, may be utilized at a residence. Rigid walled above ground pools continue to be prohibited in all respects.
2. The pool must be located at the rear of the residence and situated in such a way as to be unseen from the street.
3. Backyard pools may not be utilized after 10 P.M., and at all times are to be utilized in such a manner as to not cause an unreasonable disturbance to neighbors.
4. Minors utilizing backyard pools must be under direct adult supervision at all times, and proper social distancing shall be maintained at all times.
5. Backyard pools may only be utilized until September 20, 2020, at which time they must be removed and placed in storage. Backyard pools may not be utilized in 2021 unless specifically authorized by an Executive Order or Ordinance.
